Gender-Oriented Project Planning (GOPP)					
Target group(s):	Project groups, teams, executives (junior)				
Objectives:	Acquaint participants with Gender-Oriented Project Planning (GOPP) and practice its use on the basis of an example from one's own experience				
Method:	Group work				
Task:	The plenary session will start by collecting projects from the fields of work of the participants which can be dealt with by using GOPP. Three or four case studies (depending on the number of participants and their interests) will be selected. The working groups work on their case study according to the GOPP raster and note down their results on cards or a pin board.				
	Variation: The gender trainers either go into the working groups as gender experts for a certain amount of time, or they can be summoned by the working groups as so-called "flying experts".				
Evaluation:	The results are presented in the plenary session, and amicably discussed. The evaluation is carried out along the following questions:				
	 What approaches are there in this case? 				
	What difficulties are there?				
	What support is still necessary?				
Time:	60 - 90 minutes in working groups, 45 - 60 minutes for evaluation				
Materials:	Rectangular metaplan cards, pins, pin board, thick markers				
	Working tools see annex: "Overview: Gender-Oriented Project Planning (GOPP)"				
	If the participants are not used to working with planning templates or do not master systematic project management, you will have to schedule plenty of time for this exercise. If possible, participants should specify case studies and provide project outlines beforehand so that they can be adapted by the training team in a gender- oriented way. Indicators	 Which benchmarks document the achievement of the objectives? High percentage of male participants (initial thesis: women tend to participate in gender policy questions more than men) Satisfaction regarding the contents will be determined by means of a questionnaire : satisfaction regarding content and methods is high The dialogue space between male and female approaches was described as good by the majority of the women and men 				
Tools and methods	 Which methods and tools are to be used? Which gender policy and gender-related tools can be used? Moderated gender dialogue International composition was taken into account The lecture about working with girls was given by a man The lecture about working with boys was given by a woman Both enter into a moderated dialogue Gender mainstreaming lecture is given by a gender team The facilitator is gender-competent; key questions are prepared Written questions are handed in by the participants – it becomes evident whether the question is asked by a man or a woman, so that they can be asked in "zip merge" The composition of the workshops can be gender-homogeneous and gender-heterogeneous (please take international composition into consideration) Conclusions during the final event will be themed: "Does youth work need gender sensitivity? And who benefits from gender-sensitive youth work?"

Financial framework conditions (budget – gender budget) The location must be conveniently accessible with public transport Child care (upon request) Preparation or guidance team: gender competence Conference languages must be clarified
Requirements and support	 Which gender competence is necessary for the gender-democratic and gender-related development of the measure or project? What support is desired?
