Task clarification | Scenario: Recruitment agency

Target group (s): Training group participants

Aim: To hold gender consultations: practice task clarification

Method: Work in 2 groups / work in gender teams

 Prepare the canvassing discussion/task clarification discussion with the main protagonist in accordance with the scenario below or a self-selected scenario from an individual project in working groups of a maximum of 5 people.

Preparation time 45 minutes

 This canvassing discussion will be performed as a role-play in the plenary session.

Time

30 minutes

 Establish within the working group who will be the gender team and who will be the protagonists on the client's side.

Scenario:

Task:

Recruitment agency in city XY

The Recruitment company wants to be innovative in dealing with gender mainstreaming. The head of the company is the main facilitator (but is not present at the discussion).

The aim is to implement gender mainstreaming by integrating gender perspectives into the Recruitment Agency.

Target groups are: top-notch executive (8 people, mostly male), and a second management level comprising 65 people (a few more men than women). The managers have no previous experience with gender issues.

Protagonists:

- 2 commissioners for women's affairs, one works inside, the other outside
- Gender team

Gender consultation > Exercises for task clarification > Scenario: Recruitment agency

Evaluation:

The canvassing discussion is conducted as a role-play in the plenary session. Other group members observe the discussion in terms of the following:

- How does the gender team present itself?
- What are the main focuses of the concept in terms of content?
- Are all relevant issues addressed and clarified? (see task clarification questionnaire)?

Evaluation of the following points after the role play:

- Reflection by the protagonists: how did I feel in the respective role? What was good, what could be improved?
- Feedback from observers: What stood out? What went well from an observer perspective, what could be improved?

Time: 2 hours (45 minutes in working group, 30 minutes role play, 45

minutes evaluation)

Materials: Flipchart, pens, table and chairs for role play
